Silicosis is caused by deposition of respirable crystalline silica dust in the air sacs (alveoli). The effect of silica fume is a long-term effect and depends largely on the dust dose by the average dust concentration applied over a longer period (respirable fraction) is determined. A connection between inhalation exposure to respirable quartz dust or cristobalithhaltigen and an increased risk of lung cancer was found in epidermologischen studies.
